

If the member prefers to pay chapter dues one year at a time when he pays multi-year society dues payments, he will need to pay the chapter directly.

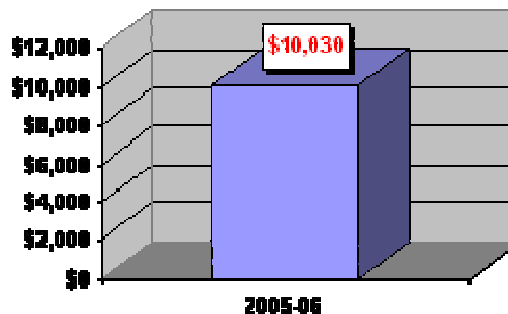

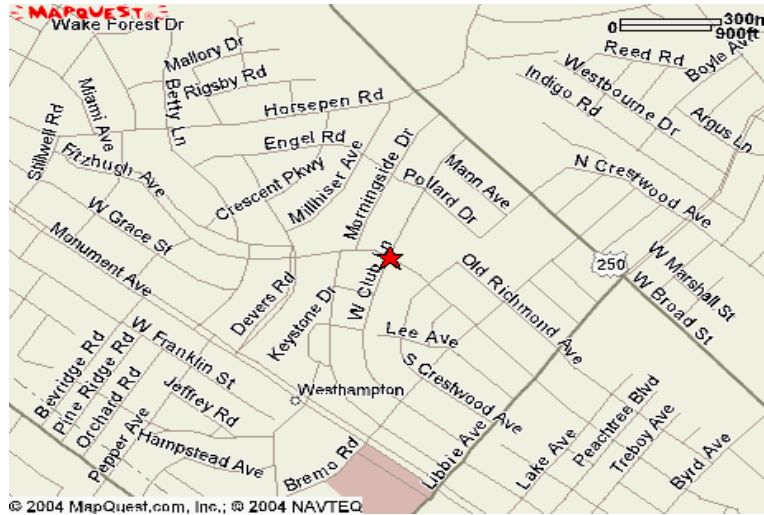
